MASSACHUSETTS CURRICULUM FRAMEWORK CORRELATIONS

The topics in *My Moral Compass* are designed to provide students with many opportunities to learn and demonstrate the skills contained in the *Standards for Literacy in History/Social Studies, Science, and Technical Subjects**.

For example, these specific reading standards and others are addressed when students evaluate and think critically about the content in *My Moral Compass.*

Reading standard 3. Evaluate various explanations for actions or events and determine which explanation best accords with textual evidence, acknowledging where the text leaves matters uncertain.

Reading standard 6. Evaluate authors' differing points of view on the same historical event or issue by assessing the authors' claims, reasoning, and evidence.

Reading standard 7. Integrate and evaluate multiple sources of information presented in diverse formats and media (e.g., visually, quantitatively, as well as in words) in order to address a question or solve a problem. The multimedia resources included in each topic are particularly useful in developing the skills given in standard 7.

All ten of the Writing Standards are addressed with assignments in the topic areas of *My Moral Compass* when students answer essay questions provided. Teachers also have the flexibility to include their own questions for students to provide arguments and evidence to meet these standards.
